Scoring Guide for PowerPoint Presentation

TOTAL POINTS POSSIBLE = 100

- Slides **(5 points)**
 - Logistics--Minimum of 5 slides, maximum of 10 slides
- Include 5 hyperlinks **(5 points)**
- Presentation has been saved, printed in handout format (3 slides per page with lines) and file brought to class for presentation and presentation is no longer than 3 minutes **(5 points)**
- First slide is a WELCOME SLIDE which includes: **(5 points per = 20 points)**
 - Your name
 - the name
 - location of the National Park and
 - your voice introducing the slide.
- Within the presentation the following are included **(5 points per = 35 points)**
 - Transitions
 - Animations
 - Photos/Images
 - Music
 - A table on at least one slide
 - A chart of graph on at least one slide
 - Footnote with name, date and slide number on each slide
- Background **(5 points)**
 - Appropriate background
 - Appropriate Color
 - Appropriate Text
 - Appropriate Font
 - Appropriate Size
- Effectiveness **(5 points)**
 - Correct information regarding location of National Park and features which visitors would see
- Content **(5 points)**
 - Accuracy of information included in the PowerPoint presentation
- Citing Sources **(5points)**
 - Include at least 3 sources
 - Correctly written citations
- Originality and organization **(10 points)**
 - Presentation includes originality and information is presented in a unique manner
 - Appropriate organization of information
